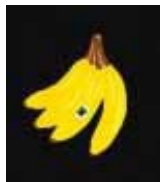
Made by Fairtrade Competition

a list of ingredients – with as many fair-trade as possible and instructions on how to serve them. Make your recipe colourful, creative and tempting to eat!



Art Attack your recipe! You are welcome to present your recipe in any way that you want, whether it is creating a collage, using photography or using textiles. A selection of the best will be presented at the Tea Party on 8th May.
